

PBIS Expectations and Behavior Policy

Be Respectful

- Respect yourself, peers, staff, and volunteers
- Respect the Club, school, and other's property
- Respect learning

Be Responsible

- Accept responsibility for you own actions
- Come prepared to Club
- Be responsible for all your belongings

Be Safe

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself
- Use body basics, line basics, and table manners
- Remain with you designated group at all times
- Use sidewalks and crosswalks in the appropriate manner
- Follow field trip policies

Behavior Policy:

1. Behavior Correction
 2. Minor Referral for the same behavior
 3. 2nd Minor Referral for the same behavior
 4. Major Referral
- Conference with Unit Director to discuss consequences

Suspension Procedure:

1. 1st Suspension= 1 day
2. 2nd Suspension= 3 days
3. 3rd Suspension= 1 week B
4. Behavior Contract must be completed by Unit Director after the third suspension, and must be signed by a parent or legal guardian before the child returns.

Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

- I will treat Club staff, volunteers, members and other parents with respect
- I will encourage my child to participate in events and activities
- I will teach my child that effort is more important than victory
- I will remember that children learn best by example
- I will work with Club staff to assist them in providing the most positive experience possible for my child
- I will arrange for my child to be picked up before Club sites close.
