In order to best align with the Fond du Lac school district, effective July 12th we will be making face coverings optional for all members, staff and visitors. However, we are strongly encouraging individuals, especially those who are not vaccinated, to continue wearing face coverings to protect others and to help control the spread of COVID-19. With the decision to go to optional face coverings, quarantine policies will also be changing. We will now be practicing the following quarantine strategies if a positive case occurs at the club:

- Elementary Students
 - o teacher/staff will be asked to name close contacts
 - o person who tested positive will be asked to name close contacts
 - if teachers/staff/positive cannot identify all close contacts, the whole class will be considered close contacts
- Teen Center
 - o Positive will be asked to name close contacts
 - Staff will be asked to name close contacts
- All close contacts, unless vaccinated, will be asked to stay home and follow CDC/WI-DHS guidelines for quarantine, isolation and release

We will also continue to implement the following mitigation strategies:

- Elementary Cohorts- will continue to be split by grade with minimal crossover
- Avoid large and/or dense crowds
- Continued emphasis on hygiene and cleaning practices
- Individuals who are symptomatic and unvaccinated must be 72 hours symptom free or a negative test before return to program
