COVID-19 Policy Update

Dear Boys & Girls Club Families:

In order to best align with the Fond du Lac school district, we will be strongly encouraging members to wear face coverings in our afterschool programs to protect others and to help control the spread of COVID-19. Boys & Girls Club employees will be modeling responsible behaviors by wearing masks during our afterschool programs. Due to a federal mandate, all individuals who ride BGC transportation will be required to wear a facemask while on that transportation. Please plan to send a face covering for your child if they will be riding on our buses or vans.

See the below information on updated masking and quarantine policies. Please note that our quarantine policies are different from the school district. Students, who are a close contact, may be able to continue attending school, but will be asked to refrain from attending our afterschool programs depending on masking and/or vaccination status.

Vaccines are available to any person aged 12 or older and are currently available on a walk in basis. For more information check here:

2021-22 School Year COVID Policy Update- 8.25.2021

Masking

Members	Masks will be Highly Recommended/Encouraged
Employees	Masks will be Required during program time
Volunteers/Community Members	Masks will be Required during program time
BGC Transportation	All individuals will be Required to wear a mask while riding transportation to or from the Club

Quarantine Process- Non Household Close Contact

Unmasked & Unvaccinated at Time of Contact	Individual will not be allowed at Club programs for 10 days from last date of contact or for 7 days if a negative test is obtained after day 5
Masked and/or Vaccinated	Individual will be allowed at Club programs but will be required to wear a mask while attending for 10 days after last date of contact
**If individual develops symptoms during this time, please see protocol for individuals exhibiting symptoms	

Quarantine Process- Household Close Contact

Fully Vaccinated	Individual is allowed at Club programs but will be required to wear a mask while attending for 10 days after last date of exposure
Unvaccinated	Individual is not allowed at Club programs for 10 days after last date of exposure or for 7 days if a negative test is obtained after day 5
**If individual develops symptoms during this time, please see protocol for individuals exhibiting symptoms	

Symptomatic Individuals

Non close contact with Symptoms	Members/staff will be sent home if exhibiting symptoms. They can return after being symptom free for 72 hours or if they obtain a negative test, they can return after symptom free. If positive they will isolate for 10 days from start of symptoms.
Close Contact with Symptoms	Members/staff will be sent home if at Club. They will not be allowed at Club programs until they are fever and symptom free for 72 hours and have obtained a negative test. If positive they will isolate for 10 days from start of symptoms. If testing is declined they will not be allowed at Club programs for 14 days after last date of contact

***All policies are fluid and BGCDFL reserves the right to update, amend and change any protocol. Policies will be evaluated on a continuous basis. Communication about changes will be provided to all people they concern in a timely manner.**
